



BIN #4008 Bodega Norton Torrontés Mendoza Argentina \$20.

Crisp aromas of wet stones, lime and eau de toilette give this Torrontes the proper air. It's lean and cut in the mouth, with green apple, pear and nectarine flavors coasting on a wave of bracing acidity. Finishes clean as a whistle.

BIN #4009 Veramonte Chardonnay Reserva Casablanca Valley Chile \$26.

An intense golden yellow color. It's fresh floral and tropical fruit aromas mingle with mineral and citrus accents. Pineapple, nectarine, melon and banana resonate in this elegant Chardonnay with freshness and a bright finish.

BIN #4010 Casa Lapostolle 'Cuvee Alexandre' Chardonnay Chile \$38.

Bright light yellow in color with subtle lime notes. On the nose, this chardonnay has elegant aromas of sweet citrus fruit, white flowers, fresh tropical fruits and sweet spices. On the palate, Cuvee Alexandre is round with an elegant mouth feel, lively acidity and a long persistent finish.

BIN #4011 Colores del Sol Malbec Mendoza Argentina \$20.

Colores del Sol is a new wine which delivers a higher level of Argentine Malbec. It is sourced exclusively from the Luján de Cuyo vineyard district within Mendoza, South America's most prestigious wine-growing region. The grapes bask in bright, pure sunlight, inspiring the wine's name: in English, 'Colors of the Sun'. It offers elegant aromatics, and a palate which frames bright, fresh fruit flavors in a medium-bodied structure.

BIN #4012 Tierra Secreta Malbec Mendoza Argentina \$26.

Meaning 'Secret Earth', Tierra Secreta exhibits elegant floral notes, leading to a full-bodied mouthful of rich, spicy Malbec fruit. With grapes grown at the foot of the Andes Mountains, Tierra Secreta's long, lively finish reflects the wine's aging in French and American oak barrels. Delightfully complex and concentrated, Tierra Secreta represents the finest Argentinean Malbec has to offer.

BIN # 4013 Llama Old Vine Malbec Mendoza Argentina \$31.

As its namesake, this wine embodies the distinctive spirit of our vineyards, spanning the foothills of the Andes. Llama is a rich ruby-purple color, and boasts elegant flavors of black berries, ripe plum and robust spices with good balance and structure.

BIN #4014 Bodega Norton 'Privada' Malbec/Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon Mendoza Argentina \$34.

Privada was one of Norton's first high-end wines. The wine's name is inscribed on each bottle by Gernot Langes-Swarovski's own hand, and it was originally reserved for family and close friends. With ample raspberry, fig bread, and mocha, this wine has a long, intensely complex finish and rich concentration. It is a seductive blend of Malbec, Merlot, and Cabernet Sauvignon.

BIN #4014 Gran Feudo by Julian Chivite Garnacha Rose Navarra Spain \$20

Harvest is carefully timed so that the grapes contain the ideal balance between acidity and ripeness at the time of picking. After limited contact with the skins during maceration, the juice is drawn off using only gravity, a method known as lágrima or tear. The free run juice creates a delicate balance of acidity and alcohol in this wine. Bright strawberry pink in color, clean and fragrant on the nose with notes of berries and fruit, lively acidity in the mouth with floral notes.
